

Stockbridge Board of Selectmen

June 7, 2018

Present: Lee Ann Isaacson, Mark Pelletier, Jim Shands, Cathy Brown, Dave Brown and Mary Russ

The meeting came to order at 7:00 PM. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mary Russ, from the White River Partnership, was present to discuss a river corridor easement for the Gaysville Campground property. If the Town were to approve the easement they would still own the land and the Vermont River Conservancy would hold an easement. The Town would agree not to develop the property, that they would not try to manage the river, and to maintain a 50 foot strip of vegetation along the river. In exchange, the Town would receive approximately \$51,000. The White River Partnership would apply for a grant to pay for the associated costs. The Town would only have to pay to have the Town Attorney review the documents. The Town would still be able to use the property for recreational purposes and Mary believes that it would be permissible to have a temporary stage on the property. She will confirm that and attend the next meeting to see if the Board is ready to move forward with the grant application.

The motion was made and seconded to approve the 100 on 100 Relay Race scheduled for Saturday, August 18<sup>th</sup>.

The Board signed a Certificate of No Appeal for the 2017 Grand List.

Dave proposed that the Town purchase an International Truck. The cost for the truck will be \$74,913 plus an additional \$59,000 for the plow and body. The trade allowance for the old truck is \$45,000. The motion was made and seconded to approve this purchase.

A grant agreement for repairs on Laury Road was signed as well as a letter of intent for a grant –in – aid for repairs on New Boston Road.

Lee Ann updated the Board on the Barbieri zoning violation. The State will be meeting with Mr. Barbieri this month to work out the details of removing the vehicles from the property.

Dave advised the Board that the slide area on Stony Brook Road has been repaired. He suggested that the Board consider adopting a culvert policy. The Board will research that further.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 PM.
