

Stockbridge Selectboard

July 19, 2018

Present: Jim Shands, Lee Ann Isaacson, Mark Pelletier, Dave Brown and Cathy Brown

The meeting came to order at 7:00 PM. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Sammie Travis lives on the lower section of Laury Road. This summer swimmers have been parking on both sides of the road blocking the road and driveways at times. The Town has ordered No Parking signs and they will be installed once they arrive. In addition, it was determined that Towed at Owners Expense signs will be added to the posts. The Board suggested that she contact the Town Constable if she continues to have problems. The Board decided that they do not wish to open the campground for parking until a plan for the use of that property is in place.

The Board signed the annual financial report. Dave advised the Board that Luke injured his thumb on the job and a workers comp claim will be started. The Board signed the quote for paving on Blackmer Boulevard from August 6-8<sup>th</sup>. The Road will be closed at that time Dave received a quote of an additional \$3,500 to fix a section of pavement on Blackmer Boulevard not included in the original quote. There is not enough money in the paving budget so he was given permission to use \$2,000 from the Paving/Reconstruction account.

The Board discussed the adoption of the zoning bylaws. The Planning Commission is nearing completion and will be presenting them to the Board soon. The Board intends to hold a public hearing as required and will hold a vote at that time.

The Board will investigate necessary steps to discontinue a town road. They are considering Luce Road, Cobble House Road and Ryer Road for discontinuance.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 PM.
