

Stockbridge Selectboard

October 4, 2018

Present: Mark Pelletier, Jim Shands, Lee Ann Isaacson, Dave Brown, Cathy Brown, Richard Lunna, Bill Edgerton, Marilyn Edgerton, Chuck Lyman, Pam Lyman, Mary Russ and Bow Thayer

The meeting came to order at 7:00 PM. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Richard Lunna has been working on locating and remonumenting all of the 18 town corners. He has found 6 of the markers and remonumented 3. He has been working on the Pittsfield corner. The property owner disagrees with Richard's determination of where the corner is. Richard has found the original stone marker and showed pictures to the board. The Board agreed to send a letter to the property owner supporting Richard's determination of the location of the marker. This project will make the lines more visible. The Board thanked Richard for his work on this project.

The Board reviewed the site plan that Richard has been working on for the town garage. He was asked to plot the proposed salt/sand shed on to the survey.

Members of the Gaysville Campground committee were present to discuss their vision for that property. Pam Lyman suggested hiking, walking and cross country trails. In addition, she thought a shelter to cover picnic tables and a grill would be nice. It was proposed that the area be for day use only with appropriate signs. It was noted that the prickly brush would need to be cleared. Mary Russ noted that all of this would be permitted by FEMA. Bow thought it would be necessary to clear a path to the beach to make it more accessible. He worried that it needed to be done soon as the property is becoming overgrown. Mary suggested that the committee develop a site plan for FEMA review. The committee will work on this over the winter and hope to be able to make improvements in the spring. Chuck volunteered to groom a trail for winter use.

Bill Edgerton pointed out to the Board that there was an error in the proposed zoning bylaw. The motion was made and seconded to amend the proposed bylaw as follows:

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.3 Effective Date: "These bylaws or any amendments thereto, shall become effective immediately after their adoption by a vote of the Town of Stockbridge by Australian Ballot".

The 2017 audit has been completed.

Dave advised the Board that they have started the Davis Hill project.
