

Stockbridge Selectboard Meeting

November 15, 2018

Present: Jim Shands, Lee Ann Isaacson, David Brown, Cathy Brown, Steve Kopyscinski, Janie Feinberg, Marilyn Edgerton, Bill Edgerton and Rob McFadden.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The Board signed certificates of election for the Justices of the Peace. Joanne Mills, Suzanne Butterfield, Donna Bryan, Tony Caparis and Kathie Burns were all re-elected.

The Zoning Bylaws were adopted as a result of the Australian ballot on November 6th and are now in effect.

Dave noted that the sandpile has finally been completely delivered and the fire truck has been returned from being repaired.

Lee Ann advised the public in attendance that she has received a formal complaint regarding the Gaysville store building. In addition she is working on the Barbieri property located on Laury Road. A zoning violation exists on these 2 properties due to abandonment for over 2 years. She plans on following up with a notice of violation. They could be fined if they don't comply. The Board tabled the request to approve funding the legal expense of pursuing these zoning violations until the next meeting. Bill Edgerton thanked the Board for taking this on and presented the board with the results of the 2012 planning commission survey indicating that 75% of the respondents felt that the town should do something about commercial eyesores. There was also discussion about the former Log Cabin Motel property. Lee Ann is willing to include that property once she receives a formal complaint.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.
