The legal voters of the Rochester-Stockbridge Unified School District, consisting of the towns of Rochester and Stockbridge, are hereby notified and warned to meet at the **Stockbridge Central School on May 28, 2019 at 7:00 PM** to consider and act upon the following articles (1-10):


To be acted upon on May 28, 2019:


- Article 1: To elect a moderator who shall assume office immediately and serve a one year term or until the election and qualification of a successor.
- Article 2: To elect a clerk who shall assume office immediately and serve a one year term or until the election and qualification of a successor
- Article 3: To elect a Treasurer who shall assume office immediately and serve a one year term or until the election and qualification of a successor.
- Article 4: To hear and act upon the reports of the School District directors and officers.
- Article 5: To authorize the District Board of Directors to borrow money by the issuance of bonds or notes not in excess of anticipated revenues for the fiscal year 2019-2020 per 16 V.S.A. §562(9).
- Article 6: Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expend \$4,408,562 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$18,427.32 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 6.84% higher than spending for the current year.
- Article 7: To elect Directors to the Rochester-Stockbridge Unified School District as follows:

- Article 8: Shall the annual meeting of the Rochester-Stockbridge Unified District be moved to the first Tuesday of April for all subsequent years beginning with the 2020 meeting?
- Article 9: To transact any other business which may legally come before this meeting.

The legal voters of the Rochester-Stockbridge Unified School District are further notified that voter qualification and registration relative to said meeting shall be as provided in Section 706(u) of Title 16, and Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.


