The meeting came to order at 6:00 PM. The motion was made and seconded to enter into executive session to conduct interviews for the Town Clerk Position.

The executive session ended at 7:00 PM. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Lee Ann advised the Board that she has sent notices of violations to Kevin Santos regarding the Gaysville store building and to Joshua Biolodeau, owner of the mobile home parked on Route 107. She will be following up with the town attorney if she does not receive responses.

The board reviewed and approved the annual Financial Management Questionnaire.

The Gaysville park committee is holding a work session on Sunday. They would like to have the jersey barriers removed and requested permission to use a brush hog and chainsaws. The board will have the barriers removed for the event and approved the use of the brush hog but did not approve the use of chainsaws. The Board would like to follow up with the committee to get their proposal of work to be done this summer.

Lee Ann volunteered to follow up with Tom Warhol requesting his proposal for services.

Dave advised the Board that he has 12 sites on Stony Brook that need repairs due to the April flooding. He intends to put that project out to bid. The Board and Dave will meet on Wednesday, June 12<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 PM to inspect the flood damaged roads to prioritize which roads must be fixed before FEMA approval.
