

Stockbridge Board of Selectmen - Draft

August 15, 2019

7:00 PM

Present: Lee Ann Isaacson, Mark Pelletier, Dave Brown, Cathy Brown and Lori Scott

The meeting came to order at 7:00 PM. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mark moved to appoint Lori Scott as Town Clerk and Treasurer, effective September 1, 2019. Seconded and approved.

Dan Levy was reappointed to a 3 year term as Town Health Officer.

The Town received notice of review from the State regarding Vermont River Tubing. The review indicates that an Act 250 permit may be required.

Keith Szpulecki gave the Board a copy of a letter he sent to the School Directors regarding the increase in the education property tax. They are working with the Agency of Education to resolve that matter.

The Board reviewed an estimate received from NRCS regarding the Lilliesville bridge area. Dave will speak with Scott Jensen, from ANR, as well as Michael LaPointe from NRCS before putting the project out to bid. It has not been determined if FEMA will pay for repairs in that area yet. Representatives from FEMA and Vermont Emergency Management met with the Town on August 15<sup>th</sup> to start the claim process. Dave was advised to proceed with his projects.

Dave will work with TRORC to complete the Community Questionnaire regarding the Gaysville bridge replacement which is in the scoping stage.

Lee Ann will follow up with the Santos zoning violation as well as the debris left on the Vosburgh property located on Route 107 in Gaysville.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 PM.
