Present: LeeAnn Isaacson, Jim Shands, Mark Pelletier, and Lori Scott.

The meeting came to order at 7:05pm. Mark read the minutes from the last meeting. Jim motioned to approve, Lee Ann seconded, and the minutes were approved.

Road Report

Mirror on Mt Hunger and 107.

Rather than place an interim solution of a mirror at the end of Mt Hunger, Dave is working on getting a grant to assist in redirecting the access on the road.

Question on Road out to Dan and Jenn Wall Howard's camp

Selectboard questioned who changed the road from Prior Dam Rd to No Town. Jim would like to add this as an agenda item for further discussion.

Whitcomb Hill Road - Work is underway but taking a little longer than expected.

Lyon Hill Road - The stumps have been removed.

New loader – Order has been placed and is scheduled for August. Dave will follow up on that date.

Road Crew – The Selectboard needs to meet with Dave regarding his plans on retirement. The Selectboard needs to review the current job descriptions on the road crew. **Action Item:** Review job descriptions and work. Report out straight time and overtime in anticipation of the 2021 Budget Cycle. This was discussed at the March town meeting where there was support for additional resources for the road crew.

Other Business:

School Election: The school budget did not pass. The school board is meeting on 7/7 to determine next steps and the Selectboard would like to invite the school board to the next Selectboard meeting on 7/16/2020 at 7:00pm to provide an update on the plan to go forward.

Prior Business:

ABLE Waste: Jim met with ABLE Waste and signed the contract for 7/1/2020-6/30/2021. Mark motioned that the Selectboard authorized Jim to sign and approve the contract. Lee Ann seconded, and the motion was approved.

Orders were sent electronically to the board members and will be signed and scanned back to the town office. Lee Ann asked about the 22K payment to Harvey's and this was the Stony Brook work. The grant reimbursement paperwork will be going into the state next week. The project came in on budget with in kind match on budget as well.

Parking at the Gaysville Bridge Swimming Hole - The board wants to collect more information on the parking concerns. They plan to go by there this weekend.

Mark moved to adjourn, Jim seconded, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:58pm.
